## Inclement Weather Reminders

- Please be careful when trucks are snow plowing. They may not be able to see cars following them or children playing in the snow.
- There is **no street parking** during and after a 2” snowfall accumulation so that our plows can clear and salt our streets, especially at the entrances and exits on Thames and Ascot, to provide easy access.
- Residents must also observe the no parking ban when a Robo call is sent or a no parking notice is posted
- If a vehicle interferes with snow plowing it will be ticketed and may be towed.
- **Remote control starters** may only be used to start vehicles that are outside the garage for safety reasons.
- **Warm up cars** outside and not in the garage to avoid exhaust fumes.

## Elevator Usage

- **Use** the stairs for oversized items and appliances
- **Please monitor** movers/delivery people. You are responsible for any damages.
